We have launched special course from **Trace Academy** for Class 10th students, offering in-depth Science and Maths coaching to help them excel in these subjects and prepare for competitive exams.

We foster spiritual growth and unity through daily prayers and special services, embracing our diverse community. Students participate in nine clubs, including Art, Eco, Literary, Heritage, Sports, Math, Cyber, Health, and Wellness, promoting overall development.
